





Engg colleges fail industry link test: AICTE-CII study

NEW DELHI: Only one in every five established engineering colleges in India is in sync with industry, a joint survey by CII and the AICTE, suggests, fuelling fears of a disconnect that threatens the employability of the country's youth.

On a score of 100, only 19% of established engineering schools secured even 40 marks in the survey conducted by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), India's apex technical education regulator.

"It is a big worry," AICTE chairman S.S. Mani said, "because the findings are a 'benchmark' for the industry."

'End disconnect between academics and industry'

Survey asks colleges to get real, seek outside

NEW DELHI: Engineering institutes that are working in sync with industry members in areas of governance, curriculum, faculty, infrastructure, services, placement and entrepreneurship for placement opportunities, according to a survey by AICTE and CII.

"It is the first time that an absolute figure of the sample size for selection, the survey sample size is 1000," said AICTE chairman S.S. Mani.

The selection criteria for the survey should have been open to all engineering disciplines - civil, electrical and mechanical engineering - and the average composite score at the national level in the study was 4.4 out of 100, he said.

Govt launches PM's fellowship scheme for doctoral research



The government has launched a fellowship scheme for doctoral research in the field of science and technology. The scheme is aimed at attracting top talent to pursue research in India.

Govt urges private sector to invest wisely

NEW DELHI: Minister of Science and Technology Jaipal Reddy on Thursday exhorted the private sector to invest 'wisely' in research and development so that the country retains its competitiveness in global trade.

"I expect private sector to invest more and more into research and innovations and partner our research institutions in solving national problems through accessible, available and affordable innovations," the Science and Technology Minister said.

"If Indian industry does not invest wisely in R&D, gaining competitiveness in global trade would become difficult for India," Reddy said after launching 'Prime Ministers Fellowship Scheme for Doctoral Research' during the 'AICTE-University Industry Higher Education Summit'.

Reddy also underlined the need to bring discoverers and solution seekers together for solving practical problems.
